step by step process

1. To register with state association, state association then forwards the names to the BCCI 2. once you get to officiate in local matches state association forward your name for Level I examination conducted every year or once every two years. 3. BCCI arranges coaching classes and conducts exam, to shortlist the candidates 4. shortlisted candidates are given induction training. There is one more examination for shortlisted candidates . 5 Then they have to appear for Level 2 Exam, which is combination of written, practical and viva 6. Then there is medical test 7. After Level 2 exam, one more induction course is conducted following which you get recognition as an Umpire.
